### **Rules and Regulations**

**May 4<sup>th</sup> – May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012**

**Entry Fee - \$155.00 All proceeds go to the Champions Kids Camp.  
All Entry Fees need to be turned in as soon as possible and are tax deductible.**

***There will be Cash and Trophies!!!!***

### ***Prize Money Distribution:***

First place in each meat category will receive \$225 and a Trophy  
Second place in each meat category will receive \$125 and a Trophy  
Third place in each meat category will receive a Trophy

*NOTE: Jackpot Open Entry. A fee of \$20.00 for cash Jackpot Open Entry (Dessert must be cooked on site) will be OPTIONAL for those who want to participate. 50-50 split between the 1<sup>st</sup> place winner and Champions Kid's Camp. Also, OPTIONAL for those who want to participate, there is a **Bloody Mary** contest for an additional \$10.00 Entry fee and 1<sup>st</sup> place takes 70% and Champions Kid's Camp takes 30%. All entries must be prepared on site.*

- 1. Move in date and times:** Any and all teams may move in as early as possible on May 4<sup>th</sup>. First come, first serve. Champion's personnel will be on location for setup. (Thursday move-in is possible with prior notification)
- 2. Space requirements:** A 30' x 30' space will be provided for all teams. Larger space, if available, may require additional fees.
- 3. Meat & Cooking Requirements:** All **ribs** must be pork spareribs only - 7 individual ribs (bone-in) all **chicken** must be fully jointed half chicken - (with breast and thigh). All **brisket** must be brisket only (7 full width slices of brisket approx. 1/4 " to 3/8 " thick).

Any and all meat and/or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, etc. will not be allowed prior to start of the cook-off as defined by the cook-off promoter.

Cooks are to prepare and cook in as sanitary manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by judging committee.

Not more than one cook shall be allowed to cook on a given pit, and multiple entries in the same category by the same cook will NOT be allowed. Multiple entries from the same piece of meat also shall NOT be allowed. It will be the promoter's responsibility to monitor and handle this in a professional manner.

**Based on the number of cooks, turn-in quantities are subject to change.** No garnish or sauce is allowed in the tray at turn-in. You may cook with sauce but it cannot be ladled onto the meat at turn-in.

TGC requires that the secret, double number system be used. One ticket attached firmly to the lid of the judging tray. The cook must retain the matching ticket until award numbers are announced. Head cook must sign back of ticket, in ink, when judging trays are issued.

**TGC judging will be final.**

**4. Chief cook's meeting:** Cook's meeting will be conducted by TGC. You will be picking up your turn-in containers at this meeting. This meeting will be at 9:00 a.m. (sharp) Saturday morning. **THIS MEETING IS MANDATORY.**

**5. Alcohol and soft drinks:** The cooking area will be sectioned or taped off. Each team may bring in their own alcoholic beverages or soft drinks but you may not come out of the taped off area with your own drinks or alcohol. Outside the taped off area you will be required to purchase all drinks from Papa's. **This will be strictly enforced and IT IS THE LAW. Please limit glass bottles or containers. Use cans or plastic when possible.**

**6. Electricity and Water:** Electricity and Water will **not** be provided. Please bring your own generators.

**7. Sanctioned Cook-off:** This will be a sanctioned cook-off. The TGC will do all judging. All cooks will agree to any and all of the rules the TGC committee may require.

**8. Clean-up:** All teams will be required to police their own area and pick-up any and all trash.

**9. Move-out time:** All teams and equipment must be moved out by Sunday morning.

**10. Information:** If you have any other questions, please call Ellen Cole at (936) 321-2767. Please leave a message on her voicemail if she is not there and when the best time is for her to call you back.

**11. Directions to Papa's Ice House:** Papa's Ice House is just south of The Woodlands, Texas. From Beltway 8 (north) and I-45 take I-45 north about 13 miles to the Rayford Sawdust exit. Exit on Rayford Sawdust and make a U-turn. Go down feeder to Pruitt Rd, turn right Papa's Ice House is about 1,000 yards down on the right hand side. Campsites are in the rear of the building.

**NOTE:** Champions Kid's Camp will have bagged ice for sale.

**NOTE:** This is a family affair. However, please remember that there will be alcohol consumed at this function. **You will be responsible for any underage family or friends that you invite.**

**NOTE: Public safety requirement!!** Once the barbecue cook-off area is setup, there will be no motorized vehicles going in and out of the cooking area, or no vehicles driving around the cooking grounds (except the Champions volunteers). Approximately 7:00 p.m. Friday night, subject to change if necessary.

**NOTE:** If you bring your dog, it **must** remain on a leash or in your camp site at all times.
